Responsibilities:

- New employee will be a critical member of client's transaction team and will support other members of the deal team, primarily but not exclusively through financial analysis
- Provide initial investment review and screening of prospective investment opportunities for the firm as well as tracking of the firm's investment pipeline
- Extensive financial modeling including sensitivity analysis to support potential investment opportunities
- Provide financial evaluation of project investment opportunities including review of project documents such as power purchase agreements, steam agreements, fuel contracts, and financing agreements
- Assist in preparation and presentation of Investment Recommendations to the firm's Executive Committee
- Participate in negotiations on behalf of the firm for new investments dealing with partnership arrangements, financing arrangements, and other project contacts which impact the project return
- Provide ongoing monitoring of assets with the firm's portfolios including review of monthly operating results and maintaining project pro forma
- Meet with project developers, project partners, financial institutions and consultants on matters related to the financial performance of projects and investments
- Establish and maintain relationship with industry, trade and professional organizations to enhance visibility of the firm and its portfolio companies in the market place
- Maintain internal database of potential investments
